

Special Hospital Workers metroCARD

Conditions of use

- Free public transport is valid for holders of a *Special Hospital Workers metroCARD* for travel to and from the following metropolitan hospitals only:
 - Flinders Medical Centre (FMC)
 - Hampstead Rehabilitation Centre (HRC)
 - Lyell McEwin Hospital (LMH)
 - Modbury Hospital
 - Noarlunga Hospital
 - The Queen Elizabeth Hospital (TQEH)
 - Royal Adelaide Hospital (RAH)
 - Women's and Children's Hospital (WCH)
 - Repat Hospital (Repat)
- Eligible employees will be issued with a *Special Hospital Workers Travel Pass* in the form of a metroCARD.
 - This metroCARD must be validated each time when using public transport services for travel to and from the above hospitals.
- The *Special Hospital Workers metroCARD* must be carried at all times when travelling on public transport.
- Holders of a *Special Hospital Workers metroCARD* must carry their Hospital Identification Card issued by SA Health.
- *Special Hospital Workers metroCARDs* are not transferable and are for the exclusive use of the employee named on the metroCARD for travel to and from an approved hospital only.
- Eligible employees travelling for purposes other than to and from approved hospitals will be required to hold a relevant metroCARD or metroticket
- SA Health and the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (DIT) will conduct regular audits of usage.
- Holders of a *Special Hospital Workers metroCARD* will be required to present their metroCARD and Hospital ID when requested by a public transport Prescribed Officer.
- Lost, stolen or damaged metroCARDs must be reported to SA Health immediately. Replacement cards will be re-issued within 10-14 days.
- *Special Hospital Workers metroCARDs* must be surrendered to SA Health if employees are no longer eligible (as determined by SA Health).
- *Special Hospital Workers metroCARDs* allow for additional value and products to be added to the metroCARD for access to discounted parking at the Tea Tree Plaza Park 'n' Ride, bike cages etc.
